Through your generous support, our church has been able to acquire **furniture for the pulpit and podium**, helping us improve the place from which the Word of God is shared. We also received support for a **file cabinet**, which has helped us safely maintain important church records and documents.

Another significant blessing was the provision of an **inverter and batteries**. Electricity can sometimes be unavailable, and this provision has helped keep our church bright during worship services and other church activities when there is no electricity. Something that may appear simple has made a meaningful difference to our congregation.

Our latest blessing has been the **construction of a safety railing on the church rooftop**. This was an important need for the protection and safety of everyone using the church building, particularly during activities on the rooftop. Once again, God provided through the love and generosity of His people.

We do not see these contributions merely as financial assistance. We see them as expressions of **Christian love, fellowship, prayer, and partnership in the work of God**. Every gift reminds us that the Church of Jesus Christ is one body. Our Next Prayer: A Hymnal for the Next Generation

As we thank God for everything He has already provided, we would also like to share a new prayer that is very close to our hearts.

Singing has always been an important part of the worship and spiritual life of our churches. The hymns we sing carry our faith, our testimony, our theology, and our Christian heritage from one generation to another. Many of the songs that strengthened the faith of our parents and grandparents continue to encourage believers today.

However, our existing hymn books have become old and worn out, and there are no longer enough new copies available for the coming generation. Without new hymnals, we are concerned that future generations may gradually lose access to many of these treasured songs of faith.

Therefore, our main church organization has prayerfully planned to **print a new hymnal with musical notation**. The vision is not only to provide hymn books for our own congregation but also to make them available to churches in different villages so that believers, young and old, can continue singing these songs to the glory of God.

The estimated amount required for this important project is approximately **€9,000**. For us, this is a significant amount, and we recognize that it cannot be accomplished through our strength alone. Therefore, before anything else, **we are bringing this need before God in prayer and trusting Him for His provision**.

We humbly invite our brothers and sisters at Markus-Kirchengemeinde to remember this hymnal project in your prayers. Please pray that God will

open the right doors, provide the necessary resources, and touch the hearts of people according to His will. Any support that God may place upon the hearts of His people will be received with gratitude, but above all, we value your prayers and continued fellowship with us.

Our desire is that these hymn books will become more than printed pages. We pray that they will become instruments through which **children, young people, adults, and generations yet to come will sing praises to the Lord and grow in their faith.**

As we look back, we can already testify that God has answered many prayers through His people. The pulpit furniture, file cabinet, inverter and batteries, and rooftop safety railing are visible reminders of His faithfulness and of your generosity. As we look forward to the hymnal project, we continue to trust the same faithful God.

May the relationship between the **Lotha Assembly of God Church, Seitheke Basa, and Markus-Kirchengemeinde, Germany**, continue to grow—not simply through material support, but through prayer, Christian fellowship, encouragement, and our shared commitment to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
